To the Parent(s) / Guardian(s) of LCSD1 students;

The Pinnacle Internet Viewer (PIV) feature of our electronic gradebook system provides secured Internet access for parents / guardians to student records on attendance, grades, and standards proficiencies. This opportunity requires Internet access and that a confidential user name and PIN Code be issued to the parent / guardian from the school.

- Receiving your confidential student ID and PIN Code
 - Come to the school office and complete a form in person with a photo ID (driver's license preferred)
 - We need to ensure the identity of who is receiving this access to student information.
 - You will get instructions to access the LCSD1 PIV feature
- The PIV requires a user name and PIN Code for each student
 - A parent /guardian with multiple students will need to complete one form per student and will be issued one user account per student.
- If you do not have Internet access
 - Contact the school office to get the latest information on your child
 - Contact the Laramie County Library System, their computers to access the Internet. Library personnel can assist you with this access to the Internet.

Please read the school literature or contact the school office for specifics on when and how this procedure will take place. To provide efficient service, some schools have arranged unique processes, times, and places for parents / guardians to acquire their student ID and PIN Code.

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Pinnacle Internet Viewer (PIV) Access Policy & Procedures

- ❖ A person may not be issued more than one PIN Code for each student ID.
- ❖ **Parent** / guardian identification must be verified in person by designated school personnel.
This verification must include a photo ID.
The preferred photo ID is a driver's license or military ID
The photo ID details must be recorded with the user ID and parent /guardian name.
The person who verified the photo ID must print and sign their name on the form.
- ❖ **Student** identification must be verified in person by designated school personnel.
This verification should include a photo ID for students who are of driving age.
The preferred photo ID is a driver's license or student ID
The details of the photo ID must be recorded with the user ID and student name.
The person who verified the photo ID must print and sign their name on the form.
This verification of student identity must be documented by the appropriate school personnel on the PIV Form.
- ❖ To receive the PIN Code the user (parent / guardian / student) must complete and sign their form.
- ❖ The pink copy of the completed form is to be given to the user (parent / guardian / student).
- ❖ The school must maintain their copies of all completed PIV forms.
- ❖ Upon verification that a PIV PIN Code has been compromised, access through that account is to be immediately disabled by the designated school personnel. (Secondary schools contact the TIS, elementary schools contact an Information Services Technician at 771.2118 or 771.2259.)
