Subject: Technology/Language Arts

Time: 30 minutes

Group: Whole group

Objective: The students will learn how to form a letter correctly.

Activities/Procedures: Teacher brings in handwriting paper in from the Gallery, as well as a letter that is going to be discussed.

Discuss: The teacher talks to the students about the strokes of each letter.

Demonstrate: The teacher shows the students how to make the letters.

Practice:

- Have a few students come to the Board to trace the original, as well as make their own.
- Have all students come to the board to make the letter with or without lines (if time permits)
- When students go to the computer lab (if not in the lab already) have them open the Notebook file from the Teachers drive. Students go to the websites to practice their letters.

Closing: Discuss the sound that letter makes and how many things around the room start with that letter.
